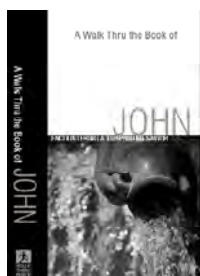

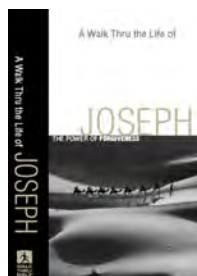

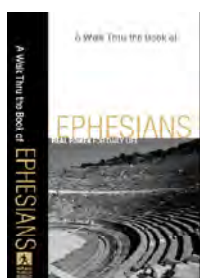
A Walk Thru the Book of John

A light came into the world, but the world did not know him. The fourth gospel shows us how we can—in deeper ways than we ever thought possible.



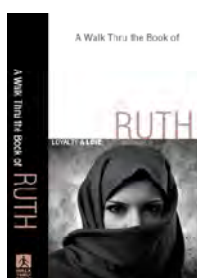
A Walk Thru the Life of Joseph

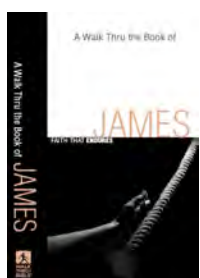
A Walk Thru the Book of Ephesians

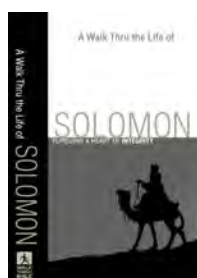
A Walk Thru the Book of Ruth

This dramatic story of redemption is filled with romance and risk. It's a beautiful picture of the gospel and a powerful example of the God who gives us hope in any situation.



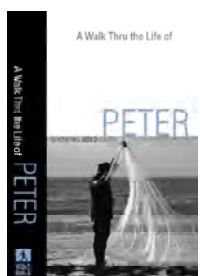
A Walk Thru the Book of James

James wrote in a volatile era—a time of religious and social upheaval—and wrestled with questions that would impact the church forever. His inspired conclusions can change your life.



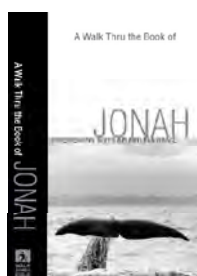
A Walk Thru the Life of Solomon

It's more than a story of a prophet and a fish. It's the story of God's love for a lost people—and a dramatic call for all who love him to share his heartbeat.

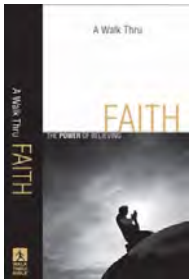

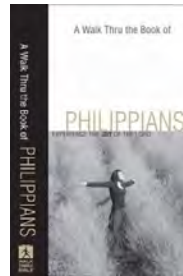

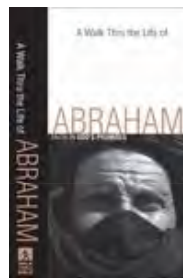
A Walk Thru the Book of Philipians

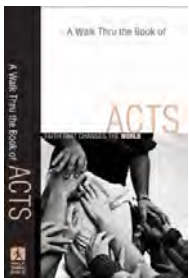
A Walk Thru Love
